

owners, and especially as FCA members, we have opportunities to participate in many wonderful events. The Vandenberg Air Force Base Exotic Car Show (Fast Cars and Faster Intercontinental Ballistic Missiles) was definitely an amazing experience and a hugely successful event.



I was somewhat concerned about the weather in early November, but the Air Force reminded me that they are the U.S. Government and promised me they could deliver perfect weather...and they did. The two day event began at Friday noon as nearly 30 cars and 45 lucky people arrived at the base Main Gate. Air Force police escorted our cars into the base as Airman and civilian base employees stood along the road waving, cheering and taking our pictures! We were in a parade! Our group was there to honor our troops, and they treated us like celebrities. We parked our cars in front of the Pacific Coast Officers Club, which created a mini car show. A buffet lunch was served as we mingled with the troops, and we met many more as they came over to admire our cars. Meeting and speaking to the airmen and officers was fantastic. One very polite woman dressed in a simple camouflage uniform was hanging out with our group; she had a bunch of stars on her cap and we learned she was Lieutenant General Susan J. Helms, who piloted the space shuttle, spent time in the international space station, walked in space and in 2011 was inducted into the U.S. Astronaut Hall of Fame. She gave us all time to chat and have our photos taken with her. She thought our cars were really cool!

After lunch, our group was given a 3 hour VIP tour of the base that was somewhat limited due to "military exercises" going on that day. Besides seeing some beautiful and unspoiled California coastline and lots of deer, we visited some unbelievably huge launch facilities and a stop at the base museum, where the curator Jay Prichard was an amazing source of space history and hilarious trivia. Many people, including me, commented that he was the



















best museum curator they have ever seen; he could have kept us entertained for hours. His explanation of how the space program developed, much of it right there at Vandenberg, was simply amazing. Later, back on our tour bus, the PA system kept shutting off and we thought that was ironic: they can launch intercontinental ballistic missiles and polar orbiting satellites, but the PA system in their tour bus didn't work.

After the tour, we all returned to the Officers Club to enjoy a steak dinner and another opportunity to meet the men and women stationed at VAFB. Spending time in their club was a wonderful experience.

Saturday morning, the weather was beautiful (guaranteed by VAFB) and over 80 exotic cars arrived at the Marshallia Ranch Golf Course, a base-owned facility, but open to the public. The cars were parked on the first fairway, and the setting was dramatic with the canyon views and the sweet central California air. There were over 40 Ferraris including 3 Daytonas, a dozen Lotuses (Loti?) and a nice assortment of cool sports cars including new and old Gullwings, E-Type Jag, Porsche Speedster and a pair of Nobles. The clubhouse was open and their "famous" Santa Maria Tri Tip barbeque lunch was served. A huge tent was erected where 9 local wineries were providing free wine tasting for the car owners (the tent was packed all day!). A rock climbing wall was on hand for the kids, and a well known Santa Barbara band kept the 2000+ spectators entertained.

It was an honor and privilege to collaborate with the team at Vandenberg (Jennifer Martinez, Robert Bumpass and Lt. Colonel Gregory Marty). During the 5 months that was spent organizing the event, we all became great friends. They felt it was one of the best events geared for the troops ever held at the base, and invited us back for 2013. We are excited about returning and hope to create a bigger and better car show in September, 2013.
