



Saturday night, after the car show our









Usually when someone turns the big sixzero, they want to just let the moment pass by as quietly as possible. But when it's in celebration of six decades of passionate competition, Ferrari went full out in Beverly Hills to recognize, honor and cherish their racing heritage.

Sixty famed Ferraris were presented on Rodeo Drive in a historic display that may never again be assembled to this magnitude. Iconic and notable Ferraris known from film and television were presented (Magnum PI 308 GTS, Miami Vice Testarossa and Ferris Bueller's Day Off California Spider among them), with a focus on many of the significant racing Ferraris including Le Mans and Daytona winners.



It was great to see so many repeats and first timers out with their Prancing Horses.

Just a reminder - since the event is a HPDE, some regular street insurance will protect your car in the unlikely event of an accident. AAA is one.

The next Willow event is scheduled for March 7-8, 2015. Do something nice for yourself and your steed!
